## Steps To a New and Better State Government

---

### ★ Redistricting

Create an independent redistricting commission to draft the New York State legislative and Congressional district lines for the 2012 elections.

### ★ Campaign Finance Reform

Support lower contribution limits, increased disclosure and public financing. In particular, support stronger and effective campaign finance enforcement with increased civil and criminal penalties for violations.

### ★ Ethics Reform

Put in place a new independent ethics oversight agency and tougher enforcement. Make the legislature more open and accountable through continued rules reform.

### ★ Election Reform

Improve election processes to extend, encourage and protect voting, including Election Day registration, better ballot design, improved polling place management/poll worker training, and measures to ensure the integrity of all ballots.

### ★ Other League Positions

The League also has positions on Health Care, the Judiciary, Natural Resources, State Finances, and Social Policy (including Women's Issues) under which we can and do take action
